FERPA FAQs for PSEO Students

FERPA stands for Federal Family Education Rights and Privacy Act. This is a federal law that protects students and their private information. All PSEO students are granted the same protections under FERPA as MSC-Southeast's regularly enrolled students.

Generally, information pertaining to the student's academic record, disciplinary record, and personal identifying information is protected under FERPA and only disclosed to the student or to others outside of the institution with written permission from the student.
